THE GRAND JURORS of McNairy County, Tennessee, duly empaneled and sworn, upon their oath, present that JOSEPH DARELL KNIGHT, on a date between August 1, 2017, and September 9, 2018, in McNairy County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, pursuant to a common scheme or plan, did unlawfully, feloniously, and knowingly, while acting as a public servant as a public works employee for the City of Adamsville, with the intent to obtain a benefit or harm another, did knowingly receive a benefit not otherwise authorized by law, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-402(a)(5), against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.
