between the 1st day of July, 2015, and the 31st day of August, 2017, through a continuous larcenous scheme, in Davidson County, Tennessee and before the finding of this indictment, Angelica Hope Cooks knowingly did obtain or exercise control over certain property, to wit: US currency, of the value of \$2,500 or more but less than \$10,000, the property of Inglewood Elementary PTO, without the effective consent of Inglewood Elementary PTO, with the intent to deprive Inglewood Elementary PTO of the property, in violation of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-103, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

their oath, present that:

between the 1st day of July, 2015, and the 31st day of August, 2017, through a continuous

fraudulent intent, did intentionally or knowingly use or allow to be used a credit or debit card, or

information from a credit or debit card, the property of Inglewood Elementary PTO to obtain

property, credit, or services, to wit: cash and credit, the value of \$2,500 or more with knowledge

that the card was not permitted to be used for purposes unrelated to PTO business, in violation

of Tennessee Code Annotated § 39-14-118, and against the peace and dignity of the State of

Tennessee.
